Brownfield RFP – ANNOUNCEMENT: Supplier Fee

Published Date: July 24, 2019

A Project selected through the Brownfield RFP and approved by the Illinois Commerce Commission will be assessed a Supplier Fee that will be due within seven (7) business days of ICC approval of the Bids. The Supplier Fee is **\$4 times the annual quantity of RECs** awarded.

For illustrative purposes, we provide below an example of the calculation of the Supplier Fees that will be due to the Illinois Power Agency. If a Project is selected through the Brownfield RFP and is approved by the Commission, and if the quantity of RECs awarded is 10,000 RECs, then the Supplier Fees due would be \$40,000, calculated as follows:

Supplier Fee per REC = \$4 per REC of the annual quantity

Annual Quantity Awarded = 10,000 RECs (no less than the partial award quantity and no more than the full quantity submitted in the Bid)

Supplier Fees for Project = Supplier Fee x annual quantity awarded = \$4.00 x 10,000 RECs = \$40,000
