Invitation to Comment on Draft Indexed REC Contract – Additional Topic for Feedback**

██████████ is submitting a comment in response to the Procurement Administrator’s (PA) Invitation to Comment on the Draft Indexed REC Contract for the Summer 2026 Procurement Event. Specifically, ██████████ is commenting on the Additional Topic for Feedback posted by the PA subsequent to the original Invitation to Comment.

In the Additional Topic for Comment, the PA asks for comments as to whether the 5% threshold for errors in the reported MWh generation for a month to trigger issuance of a revised Price Calculation Notice, as specified in the second paragraph of Section 6.1 of the Draft Indexed REC Contract is appropriate, or should be “recalibrated” to a lower percentage such as 2% or 3%.

██████████ does not oppose changing the MWh error correction threshold to a lower value than 5%. However, ██████████ believes the provisions of Section 6.1 should apply whether the corrected MWh is less than the originally-reported value or more than the originally-reported value. ██████████ seeks clarification that this is the intent of Section 6.1.
