Invitation to Comment on the Preliminary Proposal Requirements and Key Contract Terms

The Illinois Power Agency's Long-Term Renewable Resources Procurement Plan ("Long-Term Plan") provides for a procurement of RECs delivered annually from community renewable generation projects that are not photovoltaic projects under 15-year contracts. The RFP will be held in Fall 2019.

On July 30, 2019, the Procurement Administrator posted preliminary proposal requirements and draft key contract terms related to the **Non-Solar Community Renewables RFP** to the [Draft Documents](#) page of the applicable section of the procurement website (<https://www.ipa-energyrfp.com/>). Specifically, this document provides draft Part 1 and Part 2 Proposal Requirements in two tables under Section 3 (starting on page 7) and draft Key Contract Terms in a table under Section 4 (starting on page 14).

The Procurement Administrator invites interested parties to submit their comments on any aspect of the draft Part 1 and Part 2 Proposal Requirements and draft Key Contract Terms provided in these tables. The timeline and process for interested parties to provide comments is as follows:

- Please include a reference to the section name, from the left-hand column of the respective table, that is applicable to the requirement for which you are providing comment(s).

The deadline to provide comments is 5 PM Central Prevailing Time ("CPT") on Thursday, August 29, 2019.

In general, responses will be made public and published on the Procurement Administrator's website. However, should a commenter seek to designate any portion of its response as confidential, that commenter should provide both public and redacted versions. Please note that the commenter's name cannot be redacted and will be posted in the published document. Independent of any designation, if the Illinois Power Agency or its Procurement Administrator determines that a response contains confidential information that should not be disclosed in connection with a competitive procurement event, it reserves the right to provide its own redactions.
